ARRIVAL SERVICES

Pre-Semester Language Courses	Intensive pre-semester German courses are offered prior to the start of classes in the winter semester. Look under German as a Foreign Language.
Welcome Session/Orientation Day	Before lectures begin, exchange students will be invited to an official Welcome Session. Here you will meet the staff responsible for student exchange. Administration will help you complete the tasks necessary upon arrival, including city registration, setting up student accounts, etc. Attendance by all new students is essential.
Student "Buddy" Programmes	Each programme offers new student mentoring "buddy" programmes whereby Reutlingen students help new international students settle into life on campus. You will receive further information in our Welcome Guide upon acceptance to the exchange programme at Hochschule Reutlingen. Most degree programmes take part in our Students4Students buddy programme .
