



## Information for international students

when preparing your visit, entering Germany and staying at Reutlingen University  
under corona / COVID 19 conditions in winter semester 2020/ 2021

### Before departure:

- Do I come from a risk area for which a travel warning applies?  
Please consult the current list of risk areas issued by the German Foreign Ministry (Auswärtiges Amt) or the German public health advisory body Robert Koch Institute (RKI):

- Can I take a COVID-19 test in my home country which will be recognised by the RKI before I depart?

The test result must be no more than 48 hours old when you enter Germany (please bear in mind different time zones!)

If the result is negative → you may enter Germany, no quarantine is necessary

If the result is positive → no departure is possible, no entry into Germany

### When entering Germany:

Option a) With documentary evidence of a negative test result – see above

→ continue your journey to your place of study → Report to your Degree Programme Coordinator at Reutlingen University

Option b) Take a test at the airport – see for example:

If the result is negative → Continue to your place of study (no quarantine)

→ Report to your Degree Programme Coordinator at Reutlingen University.

If the result is positive → Go to your place of study / accommodation by the most direct route and spend the next 14 days in quarantine → Report to your Degree Programme Coordinator at Reutlingen University.

Option c) No test at the airport →

Go to your place of study / accommodation by the most direct route and spend the next 14 days in quarantine →

Immediately upon arrival at your place of study: contact and report to your Degree Programme Coordinator at Reutlingen University.





**In general, the entry regulations of the state of Baden-Württemberg apply!**

**During your stay:**

You are obliged to observe the prescribed hygiene measures on the campus and in the student hostels as well as in certain public places (maintain social distancing of 1.5 metres / 5 feet, wear a face covering over your nose and mouth, disinfect and wash your hands etc.) See <https://www.reutlingen-university.de/aktuelles/aktuelles/meldungen/aktuell/2020/information-about-the-coronavirus/>
